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Jeff Francer is Senior Vice President and General Counsel of the Association for Accessible Medicines, formerly the Generic Pharmaceutical Association, where he leads the association's legal and international trade advocacy.

Mr. Francer served as Associate Chief Counsel of the Food and Drug Administration from 2003-2005, where he advised agency leaders on issues involving the regulation of drugs and biologics including clinical investigation, manufacturing, promotion, enforcement, and legislative matters. After leaving the FDA, Mr. Francer served as Associate General Counsel, U.S. Compliance Officer, and Chief Privacy Officer of Biogen Idec, Inc. At Biogen Idec, Mr. Francer was the primary in-house counsel on FDA issues, fraud and abuse prevention, and patient privacy. Mr. Francer was also responsible for overseeing the U.S. corporate compliance program.

Immediately prior to joining AAM, Mr. Francer served as Vice President and Senior Counsel of the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers of America (PhRMA) where he was the principal counsel to the association on issues relating to the research, development, and regulation of medicines in the US and globally.

Mr. Francer received his A.B. in Public Policy and Economics from Brown University, his M.P.P. from Harvard University, and his J.D. from the University of Virginia.
